



## **‘Growing Success’: statewide community summit on depression**

Dick Cavett will talk about his experience with depression at a June 19 statewide summit on creating pathways to the successful treatment of the disease.

The summit will be hosted by the University of Nebraska Public Policy Center, in partnership with NET Television.

Cavett, a Nebraska native, will be keynote speaker for the event, which is set for 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

The theme is “Growing Success,” and the summit will feature a panel of local experts on depression and a short workshop about what Nebraska communities can do to plan for and create opportunities to treat it successfully. Among topics: Depression 101, success stories of depression survivors and depression among military families, elderly people and teens.



The intended audience includes depression survivors and their friends and family, faith leaders, counselors, caregivers, parents, students, as well as interested community members.

The summit will be at the NET Television Studios in Lincoln and will be broadcast live via video conference to satellite locations in Chadron, Grand Island, Omaha, and Scottsbluff.
